Horseshoe Rules 2022

Bye Team: If the schedule includes an uneven # of teams, the team with a bye on the schedule must pitch on their scheduled evening and must beat 90% of their handicap. If they do not pitch they will automatically forfeit their games (0-12) for that evening. By e teams are luck of the draw for the season. By e teams can be used as subs. If you are on a bye, no throw.

Dates of Play: May 12, 19, 26 June 2, 9, 16, 23, 30 July 7, 14, 21, 28 Aug. 4, 11 (Rain Dates Aug. 18, 25)

Forfeits:

7:00 p.m. is game time

7:10 is forfeit time for the 1st game

8:00 is forfeit time for the entire evening.

You must have 4 people to compete *on both pits* for the evening.

You must have 2 people to compete on one pit. If you only compete on one pit you begin the event in the evening 0-6 and compete for the other six games.

The team winning by forfeit is responsible for turning in their sheet. Please inform the league coordinator (Jim Riley-Riley's Ringers) of the forfeit.

As a courtesy, teams who know they are forfeiting that evening should call the Parks Department. The Parks Department will make every attempt to contact the league coordinator and the team winning by forfeit. Games Played Per Night: Each team pitches 12 games of 26 shoes per night. Score 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 points per two shoes pitched.

Handicaps: Each new team/player will establish a new handicap the first evening. After the handicap is established, teams will go back and determine who won the first three games and then finish the rest of the evening using the newly established handicap.

Everyone will establish a new handicap to start the season on May 3rd.

League Fees: League Fees are \$200.00 per team. Checks should be made payable to St. Charles Parks Department. When paying league fees to the league coordinator check or money order is the preferred payment but cash will be accepted. If you pay at the Parks Department (1900 Randolph,

Plaques: Plaques will be awarded for $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ Place for league play and 1^{st} & 2^{nd} Place for Playoffs. Usually provide 6 plaques per place.

Rain Out: If a week is rained out we will pitch that week's schedule on the next available week. The schedule does not advance until the previous week is completed.

Rain out number: 636-944-6001, option 1—will have other program information also. Please listen carefully.

Rosters: Weekly team sheets will serve as the team roster also. Please write legibly and include **FIRST & LAST** name on the summary sheet. Please update your sheet the first evening.

<u>Schedules</u>: Games on the schedules are by the week. If a week is rained out that weeks schedule will be pitched on the next available week until completed. Example: Week 1, Week 2 etc...., week 2 will not be played until week 1 is completed.

Score sheets: Score sheets for the games are available in the Box. See League Coordinator for these score sheets.

Standings: Standings will be in the box along with your weekly summary sheets.

Summary Sheets: Each team is provided a summary sheet each week to record and turn in their scores.

<u>Please make sure won/lost record for the evening is legible (clearly marked) because score sheets will be sent by email to the league statistician</u>. Please list players first and last name.
